Chris Schalk will portray Washington Huggins who championed the cause of agriculture and developed the popularity of county fairs in Barren County. Rounding out the tour will be Kelly Underwood as she portrays Miss Maude Redding, a milliner and believed to be the first beautician in Glasgow.
